Scalloped Potato Gratin

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 C heavy cream
- 3 bay leaves •
- 2 sprigs fresh thyme plus more to finish
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1/2 tsp. grated nutmeg (or ground)
- Salt and ground black pepper
- Butter (to grease dish)
- 2 lbs russet potatoes, peeled and sliced to 1/8" thickness
- 1/2 C graded parmesan cheese, plus more for finishing

Directions

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. In saucepan, heat cream with bay leaves, thyme, garlic, nutmeg, and some salt and pepper. While the cream is heating, butter a casserole dish. Remove bay leaves and thyme with slotted spoon. Pour heated cream into a bowl with the potato slices. Mix gently. Sprinkle parmesan over potatoes. Add a little salt and pepper to season. Mix gently. Spoon some cream in the bottom of the casserole dish. Spoon potatoes into dish. Pour remaining cream over potatoes. Add fresh thyme leaves and parmesan on top. Bake covered and vented for 40 minutes. Enjoy!
