- Please keep your voices down while waiting for the bus, as neighbors may still be sleeping.

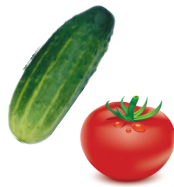

Cucumber Tomato Salad

- * 3 Cups peeled and sliced cucumbers
- * 3 Roma tomatoes, sliced into chunks
- * 1/3 cup chopped red onion
- * 1/4 cup olive oil
- * 3/4 cup apple cider vinegar
- * 1/2 Tbsp red wine vinegar
- * 1/2 tsp dill weed
- * 1 tsp sugar
- * 1/4 tsp each of salt & pepper



Place salad ingredients in a large bowl and toss. Mix dressing ingredients in small bowl; stir to combine well and drizzle over salad.
