<u>Humidity in the Home</u>

It's that time of year again where the temp drops, we stop opening windows and doors as much, gas furnaces are turned on and comfort cooking begins. All these things produce and trap moisture in our homes. Moisture will start to build up on your windows proving you have a tight home. The first sign of excess moisture is the fogging or frosting of windows with a large swing in temperature. There are a handful of ways to control the humidity in your homes over the winter months.

1.Check/replace furnace filter

2. Leave bedroom doors and bathroom doors open when not in use.

3. Always use exhaust fans and ventilators when cooking, bathing, or washing. It's recommended to run these fans for at least 15 to 20 mins after each activity.

4. When possible, control sources of air moisture. Shut off any humidity devices. Always mix hot and cold water as they come out of the faucet.

5. Don't maintain excessive room temperature within your home. 68 degrees is very comfortable.

Twigs and Stick reminder

Please do not pile branches in the street. Over the winter months we will not be picking up branches from homesites. I recommend starting a pile behind your deck and once it is Spring you can move the branches to the curb for us to pick up after the thaw and mud settles in the back.

A friendly reminder to please clean all snow and ice from your driveway, sidewalk, and front entrance, including any snow left by the street plowing. Please <u>DO NOT</u> push your snow into the street.

Q: Should I worry about ice damming after a heavy snow?

A: Yes. As snow melts and re-freezes water can collect at the edge of your roofline. It is a good idea to use a roof rake to remove the snow along your roofline which can help prevent ice dams that can lead to damage on the roof and cause leaks inside your home. Be very careful if you are climbing on top of your roof to shovel as it can be very slick. Also, be careful not to damage your roof vents.
